CLASS 3 NOVICE SMALL HUNTER Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 158cms (15.2hh) but exceeding 148cms (14.2hh). Not to have won a first prize of £60, or a total of £200 before 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2010.

CLASS 4 NOVICE LIGHTWEIGHT HUNTER Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over, not having won a first prize of £60, or a total of £200 before 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2010, excepting prize money in 4 yr old classes only

CLASS 5 NOVICE HEAVYWEIGHT HUNTER Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over not having won a first prize of £60, or a total of £200 before 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2010, excepting prize money in 4 yr old classes only.

CH 1 CHAMPIONSHIP - 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 2-5 to compete. Champion & Reserve champion to compete for the Ridden Supreme

CLASSES 1, 6-9 are qualifying event for the RIHS and only horses registered on the 2010 Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on the entry forms and owners and riders must be members of the society. The Two highest placed horses in each class will qualify to enter the RIHS

Classes 6-9 are qualifying classes for the NHSCS the three highest placed horses in the Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight and Small will qualify to enter the NHSCS. No horse lower than third will qualify. All regulations applicable to the HOYS qualifiers will also apply to NHSCS qualifiers

Classes 6-9, 12 & 13, 41 & 42 are qualifiers for the Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) challenge- The qualifier from each of the above classes will be the highest placed horse ( not already qualified) that is registered or eligible to be registered on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse register, i.e with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding. The horse need not be registered to qualify but MUST be on the IDHS(GB) register by the time of the Championship, which will be held at the IDHS(GB) Annual Breed Show on 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> September 2010 at Weston Lawns Equitation centre, Bulkington, Coventry Warwickshire. In the final the Champion will be awarded £1000 in prize money plus a trophy and a Blue Chip rug. The reserve champion will be awarded £500 and 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> inclusive will be awarded £100 each.

- B. Accept remuneration whether it be monetary or goods in kind for employment in connection with horses, in a racing, showing, livery stables or riding school (instruction at pony club & riding club excepted) since 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008
- C. Show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm, or a horse of which his or her immediate family, accept livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate concern since 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008
- D. Show a horse, which a professional rider has qualified in weight or Small Ridden Hunter class during the current year, unless the horse has subsequently been re-registered under new ownership.
- E. Show a horse, which is exhibited by a professional rider at the same show Exception of

- Working and Ladies hunter classes.
- F. A professional rider must not ride or exercise an amateurs horse on the day it is competing in a Amateur class
  - G. Professional show persons must not enter Amateur Ring whilst the classes are in progress.

**CLASS 12 OPEN WORKING HUNTER QUALIFYING CLASS** held under S.H.B.(GB) rules 2010. Mare or Gelding, 4yrs old or over exceeding 153cms. Riders to have attained their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday. To be judged - 60% for jumping performance, 40% as for Hunter classes. The jumping will be 40% for actual jumping and 20% for style. Fences to be minimum of 8, and maximum of 12 in number, and a maximum of 3ft 9in at the discretion of the judge. Fences should have natural appearance, and not be easily dislodged. The manner of the going taken into account. Refusals to be severely penalised. No change of rider or tack will be allowed. The judging of the ride and conformation will be 40% this will be judged after the jumping phase is completed. Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A Show jumper or Advanced Event Horse as at 1<sup>st</sup> January in current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes. Horse with minus scores will not be required for the second phase of the class.
